<u>Digital Citizen</u>: someone who uses information technology to be a part of society


<u>Digital Etiquette</u>: treating others the way you would want to be treated online: with respect and kindness

<u>Cyberbullying</u>: the use of technology (computer, phone, tablet, etc.) to purposely be unkind to someone


