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FLVS Students Outperform State Average in End-of-Course Exams

ORLANDO, Fla. (Aug. 5, 2015) – Florida Virtual School students bested the state average in End-of-Course (EOC) exams taken by Florida students in spring of 2015. The benchmark tests measure how well students have mastered course material.

As the state requires more EOC assessments, students in FLVS Part Time and FLVS Full Time programs continue to surpass the average set by students in traditional schools.

FLVS Part Time students performed higher than the state average on the Biology 1 EOC assessment by 4 percent. They also out performed the state average by 16 percent on the Civics EOC assessment and 10 percent on the U.S. History EOC assessment.

FLVS Full Time students also surpassed the state average on these EOC assessments. They scored 14 percent higher than the state average on the Biology 1 EOC assessment. Full Time FLVS student scores were 13 percent higher on the Civics EOC assessment and 18 percent higher on the U.S. History EOC assessment.
